

I also informed her of Steve's reporting of criminal extortion to the police and she requested the case number (E99731480).

I, too, highly recommend you all contact the Ombudsman. The more people that report they have been hit by Robodebt No 2, the more likely it is that something will be done. Today I will be uploading all the information I have and emailing it to her, as requested.

Steve Ridd has been doing an amazing job but it is really up to us to back up the 'noise' he has been creating & contact everyone we can - your local MP, Ray Hadley & Ben Fordham at 2GB, and anyone else who can publicise this matter. I am also trying to contact Michael Pascoe, a reporter from The New Daily who has been reporting on the first Robodebt but I am having difficulty finding a contact for him.

This is all definitely taking momentum now, especially with A Current Affair interested in a follow up segment.

I wish you all well in your endeavours in this fight against the money grab.

has received the 'Invoice' – it was actually sent to her old address so she only got it yesterday – and I attach herewith, as Robodebt p1 & p2..


I think it may be too late, and I have yet to sit down with Taylor to go through everything, but will be calling tomorrow anyway.
